The LCA Percussion Ensemble provides students with a space to develop their instrumental music techniques and knowledge of music theory. Throughout the course of the school year, students will learn several musical selections within an ensemble context, and will have the *option* to prepare a solo on snare drum, mallets, timpani, or multi-percussion. Students will study a wide variety of literature, including classical, rudimental, folk/ traditional, contemporary, novelty, and music from non-Western cultures.

Learning Outcomes

- Students will cultivate a strong foundation in percussion performance techniques.
- Students will strengthen their knowledge of music theory and history.
- Students will develop the skills necessary to actively listen to and participate in the making of music.

Expectations/ Policies

- 1. **Treat others as you want to be treated.** We strive to foster an environment that is conducive to learning, in which everyone feels safe and respected. Please speak with an adult if you feel as though these standards are not being met.
- 2. **Engage in one conversation at a time.** In a large class full of percussion instruments, it is very easy for side-conversations and "hacking" to escalate into a total cacophony. You are expected to be actively engaged in rehearsal activities at all times, even when the focus of rehearsal is on another player/ group of players.
- 3. **Keep the band facilities clean and organized.** Every instrument and implement has a home. When you are finished with a piece of equipment, you are expected to store it properly, regardless of the state in which you found it. All food and drink except for water should remain outside the room.
- 4. **Play and maintain your assigned instrument.** You are responsible for taking care of your instrument. Please make sure that you are only playing on your assigned instrument, and that you are playing with the appropriate implement(s).
- 5. **Attend all after-school rehearsals and performances.** Attendance is vital to the success of a music ensemble. Absences and tardiness for any reason can have a significant impact on the ability of the group to perform at its highest level. Please communicate with Mr. Wade via email promptly if a conflict should arise.
